Clarendon Hills Park District Lions Park Pool Rules Posted

- 1. Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children. Lifeguards are on duty to enforce rules & respond in case of emergency.
- 2. Admission to the pool shall be refused to all persons having contagious, infections conditions. Bandages of any kind are not permitted.
- 3. Persons under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older during the entire visit.
- 4. Children who are not yet potty-trained are required by the Department of Public Health to wear both a swim diaper and plastic pants while in the pool facility.
- 5. No coolers or outside food and beverage allowed.
- 6. All persons are strongly encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool.
- 7. School age children (6 year old and up) may not go through the opposite sex locker room.
- 8. No video cameras or camera phones are allowed in the locker room or wash room areas.
- 9. Proper swimming attire is required; no cutoffs, shorts or street clothes.
- 10. Children's buggies, wagons, or playpens are not allowed on deck. Strollers are allowed on deck provided that the stroller is 10 feet away from the water.
- 11. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices must be within one arms reach of a parent or guardian at all times.
- 12. No smoking is allowed in the facility or within 15ft of any building.
- 13. Possession and/or consumption of alcohol beverages is strictly forbidden on park district property. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the pool facility.
- 14. Glass, soap, lotion, cigarette/tobacco or other material which might create hazardous conditions shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the pool deck.
- 15. No running, boisterous or rough play is permitted.
- 16. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted. The pool water is not suitable for drinking.
- 17. Diving in less than 5 feet deep is not permitted except when allowed for competitive swimming and training.
- 18. Only soft squish balls will be allowed in the pool.
- 19. Those paying daily admission must have a hand stamp if leaving and reentering the facility. No cash refunds will be issued.
- 20. All patrons must shower before leaving the sand area.
- 21. The Lions Park Pool staff reserves the right to dismiss a patron(s) whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others without refund.
- 22. Additional rules may be added by management as needed.

- Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children. Lifeguards are on duty to enforce rules & respond in case of emergency.
 - Obey all staff
 - If LG cannot watch water, then whistle for Manager
- Admission to the pool shall be refused to all persons having contagious, infections conditions. Bandages of any kind are not permitted.
 - Including sunburn
 - Abrasions no healed
 - Corn plasters
 - Bunion pads
- Persons under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older during the entire visit.
 - Parents will be contacted for children left unattended
- Children who are not yet potty-trained are required by the Department of Public Health to wear both a swim diaper and plastic pants while in the pool facility.
 - Disposable diapers are not allowed
 - Baby changing stations in locker rooms
 - No deck changing
- No coolers or outside food and beverage allowed.
 - Coolers must be stored in vehicle and consumed outside the pool facility in the pavilion or picnic area
 - No outside food allowed in concessions area
- All persons are strongly encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool.
- School age children (6 year old and up) may not go through the opposite sex locker room.
 - Ask for assistance to escort your child through same sex locker room.
- No video cameras or camera phones are allowed in the locker room or wash room areas.
- Proper swimming attire is required; no cutoffs, shorts or street clothes.
 - A white t-shirt, swim shirt or water shoes are allowed
 - Swim suit must have liner
 - Undergarments are not allowed
- Children's buggies, wagons, or playpens are not allowed on deck. Strollers are allowed on deck provided that the stroller is 10 feet away from the water.
 - A person 18 years or older must accompany stroller at all times
 - Outside lawn chairs are not permitted
 - Do not save chairs/lounges
 - Chairs not allowed within 6 feet of pool gutter or allowed in pool
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices must be within one arms reach of a parent or guardian at all times.
 - U.S. Coast Guard lifejackets are available for use in the Pool Office. An item is needed as a deposit.
- No smoking is allowed in the facility or within 15ft of any building.

- Possession and/or consumption of alcohol beverages is strictly forbidden on park district property. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the pool facility.
- Glass, soap, lotion, cigarette/tobacco or other material which might create hazardous conditions shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the pool deck.
 - Bags are subject for inspection
 - Only plastic water bottles are allowed
 - Food and beverages may be purchased at concessions stand and to remain in concessions area
- No running, boisterous or rough play is permitted.
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted. The pool water is not suitable for drinking.
- Diving in less than 5 feet deep is not permitted except when allowed for competitive swimming and training.
- Only soft squish balls will be allowed in the pool.
 - Items not allowed
 - i. Water torpedoes
 - ii. Noodles (expect on Noodle Night)
 - iii. Frisbees or inflatable toys
 - iv. Swim masks, fins and snorkels
 - v. Any other items deemed inappropriate by Management
- Those paying daily admission must have a hand stamp if leaving and reentering the facility. No cash refunds will be issued.
 - Facility Closing Policy with no refunds
 - Lighting, severe rain or any condition that would jeopardize swimmer safety
 - Forecasted temperatures below 68 degrees according to National Weather Service at 11:30am. The pool will remain closed until 1pm, at which time the weather will be re-assessed every 2 hours from 3-5pm. If the pool cannot open by 5pm, it will be closed for the remainder of the day
 - Mechanical failure or water clarity concerns.
 - Low attendance at the discretion of Management
 - Park features may be closed due to low attendance; an announcement will be made 30 minutes prior to closing
- All patrons must shower before leaving the sand area.
 - Including volleyball court
- The Lions Park Pool staff reserves the right to dismiss a patron(s) whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others without refund.
- Additional rules may be added by management as needed.
 - The Clarendon Hills Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items
 - It is encouraged not to bring valuables to the pool
 - Lockers are available for rent for \$.25 each
 - Paging patrons is not allowed
 - Lost & Found items are at Admissions; unclaimed items are donated
